3.1.2 LICENSING ACT 2003

Notification of APPLICATION FOR GRANT/VARIATION OF PREMISES LICENCE

Upper Sapey Gold Club – as previously distributed

Councillors agreed, with one abstention, not to support this application in its current form (RW/JW)

The clerk was asked to complete the form issued by the licensing department on behalf of the councillors stating their concerns, and that of parishioners, and requesting that the license should be limited as follows:

The serving of alcohol and playing of music inside the venue should cease at 11pm from Monday - Thursday.

The serving of alcohol and playing of music inside the venue should cease at 1.30am on Saturday and Sunday.

The serving of alcohol and playing of music inside the venue should cease at midnight on Sundays.

The serving of alcohol and playing of music inside the venue should cease at 2am on New Year's Day.

That a separate license should be issued for any outdoor events as & when required.

It should also be stressed that:

Councillors and parishioners are very concerned about the disorder, drunkenness and anti-social behaviour of some users of this venue.

Councillors and parishioners are very concerned about the physical safety of people using the venue, especially road users when entering and exiting.

Councillors and parishioners are very concerned about the noise from music, litter and light pollution should this license be granted
