2. Parish Council's Annual Report read by the Chairman Cllr Wheeler

This year there have been six regular meetings.

There have been 16 planning applications. Of the 18 applications, 2 are pending, 12 were granted, 2 were refused, 1 was a Certificate of Lawful Use of Development and 1 did not require prior approval.

The parish council did not support 1 of the applications which was subsequently rejected by HCC planning department.

Council also received 1 public path diversion order.

The precept was set at £5,000 from which grants of £200 were made to each of the four churches. There were further grants of £500 to each of the two village halls. An additional grant of £100 was given towards the new defibrillator which is to be sited in the old telephone kiosk at Sapey Common


We continued with Lengthsman / P3 Scheme and was awarded a grant of £4230 which enabled our appointed lengthsman to carry out work clearing ditches, cutting back visibility splays, and clearing footpaths and repairing stiles, etc.
